### **General info on transportation**

Naples Naples International Airport (Capodichino Airport) is located about 10 km from the city center and can be reached in approximately 30 minutes by taxi or bus.

Immediately outside Terminal 1, where all incoming flights arrive, you will find the Alibus shuttle service. This coach connects the airport with the city center and stops at both Piazza Garibaldi (near Napoli Centrale railway station) and Piazza Municipio, opposite Molo Beverello port. Tickets can be purchased directly on board.

If you arrive at Leonardo da Vinci–Fiumicino Airport in Rome, you can take the Leonardo Express train, which connects the airport to Roma Termini railway station in about 30 minutes. The train station is located inside the airport, near Terminal 3 international departures.

From Roma Termini to Napoli Centrale railway station, you can travel on Frecciarossa or Italo high-speed trains. The journey takes just over one hour, with frequent daily departures. Once in Naples, taxis are available to take you either to Molo Beverello for the hydrofoil service or to Calata Porta di Massa for the fast ferry service.

### **How to get to Anacapri**

#### **Public Buses**

Public buses on Capri are minibuses that accommodate approximately 10 seated passengers, as the island's narrow roads cannot be navigated by standard-sized buses. During the summer season, buses are often crowded and long queues may form at the main stops, although services generally operate more frequently to meet increased demand.

#### **Taxi**

The fastest way to travel from the dock on Capri to Anacapri is by taxi. Capri taxis can carry up to seven passengers and are often open-top vehicles, offering a scenic ride along the island roads. For small groups, taking a taxi can be just as convenient and often not significantly more expensive than using the public bus service.
